
In 1958, Jørgen Rasmussen and his brother began working for KEVI A/S. The twins designed a villa for KEVI's CEO, Bent Harlang.



KEVI is a classic office chair designed in 1958. in 2016, after nearly 60 years on wheels, it was time to renew the chair. The sketches for the stackable chair have been in the Jørgen Rasmussen's archives for years and in 2016, it became reality. The four-legged KEVI was born. A stackable KEVI in two models, with chrome or wooden legs.

KEVI with four legs is a re-make of the classic swivel chair from 1958, with the same seat and back as the KEVI 2533.
