Designed in 1952, the striking PK4™ is a modern, relaxed lounge chair that consists of two materials - one unbroken halyard length and seven steel tubing pieces welded into a unified frame. Radiating Poul Kjærholm's distinctive elegance through a light, minimalistic expression in steel and flag halyard, it perfectly exemplifies Kjærholm's visionary approach where art and design intersect.

ABOUT THE DESIGNER

Poul Kjærholm was a trained cabinet maker and continued his studies at the Danish School of Arts and Crafts in Copenhagen. He had a particular interest in different construction materials, especially steel, which he considered a natural material with the same artistic fineness as other natural materials. Poul Kjærholm was first employed at Fritz Hansen for about a year, where he designed a number of noteworthy chair prototypes. In 1955, Poul Kjærholm initiated his collaboration with manufacturer Ejvind Kold Christensen, which lasted until Kjærholm's death in 1980. In 1982, Fritz Hansen took over the manufacture and sales of "The Kjærholm Collection", which was developed over the period 1951 to 1967.

MATERIAL

The frame of the PK4[™] lounge chair is made of seven stainless steel tubing pieces. A long length of flag halyard wound around the seat and back of the curved steel frame forms the chair. The halyard is made from linen casing weaved around a nylon core.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Frame: Made from four tubes and three rod, all from stainless steel. Tube ends are fitted with a turned end cap in solid stainless steel. Tubes are bended to shape and the entire frame is welded together.

Seat: 66 m of line is used - and wound by hand.

PE foam and cardboard are used as protection on the frame. The chair is covered with a plastic bag and shipped in cardboard. All packaging material can be recycled.
