GRAND PRIX™

The Grand Prix™ chair is a chair with graphic edge. It was introduced at the Designers' Spring Exhibition at the Danish Museum of Art & Design in 1957. Later that year, the chair was displayed at the Triennale in Milan where it received the Grand Prix, the finest distinction of the exhibition. The celebrated chair comes in both a steel or wood base and can be customised through a series of colours, wood types and upholstery.

DESIGNER

The collaboration between Arne Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen dates back to 1934. It was not until 1952 however that the team got its breakthrough with the Ant™. It was succeeded by Series 7™ in 1955, thereby enabling both Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen to write their names into furniture history.

MODELS

3130: Chair w. tube legs (stackable up to 5 chairs)
4130: Chair w. wooden legs

MATERIAL

Shell: The shell of the Grand Prix™ chair is made of pressure moulded veneer - 7 layers of inner veneer and 2 layers of outer veneer on front and back. The inner veneer is always beech and the outer veneer is available in 2 different natural veneers (Oak and Walnut).

The 3130 chair is also available in two finishes: Coloured Ash or Lacquered, in 16 different colours. Model 4130 is also available in Coloured Ash in 3 colours (White, Nine Grey and Black)

Both models are also available with front or full upholstery in fabric or leather.

Bases: The base for 3130 is made of 14 mm steel tubes with 4 legs and leg ferrules of black synthetic material. The base is mounted with black support spacers and a black cover cap. The base is available in chromed steel or powder coated steel in 6 colours. The base for model 4130 is made in veneer matching the veneer or colour of the shell (non-stackable).

Model 3130 is available in 3 seat heights: 43/46/48 cm | 17.3"/18.1"/18.9". Model 4130 is available in 2 seat heights: 43/46 cm | 17.3"/18.1".

Materials in %:

Models without upholstery: Plastic 2%, Steel 42%, Wood (Laminated beech) 56%
Models with upholstery: Fabric 5%, Steel 37%, Foam 2%, PUR 2%, Wood (Laminated beech) 54%

Items with a weight <1% of the total product weight are not included in the figures. The upholstery percentage may vary depending on the upholstery type.

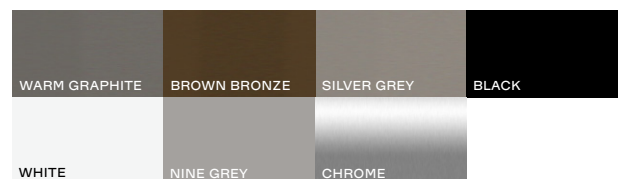

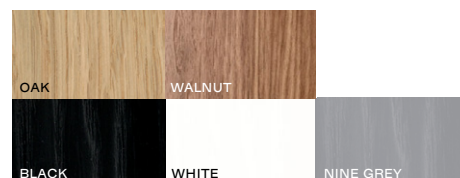

UPHOLSTERY

The upholstery for Grand Prix™ is available in the following selection of fabric and leather types:

Fabric: Christianshavn™, Canvas, Capture, Diablo, Fame, Remix, Tonus, Divina, Divina Melange, Divina MD, Fiord, Hallingdal, Steelcut, Steelcut Trio, Sunniva, Comfort

Leather: Essential, Soft, Grace, Embrace, Natural, White, Optical White

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Shell: The shell is made of laminated, pressure moulded veneer - 9 layers in total. The 2 outer layers are made in sliced veneer of different wood types, the 7 inner layers are made of beech. The veneer layers are glued together with water-based urea-formaldehyde glue. Un-upholstered chairs are coated with polyurethane lacquer, which prevents the emission of formaldehyde.

Upholstery: The Grand Prix™ chairs are available with upholstery. Several textiles are available with EU Eco flower mark. The shell is padded with polyurethane (PUR) foam. A water-soluble glue is used for bonding of textile to the foam and foam to the shell.

Base: The base is made of chromed steel or powder coated steel. Fritz Hansen uses both trivalent chromium (Cr3) and hexavalent chromium (Cr6) for chromium plating. Fritz Hansen will convert to solely using trivalent chromium (Cr3) when the capacity in the Industry allows it. The wooden legs consist of 23 layers of laminated beech veneer with oak or walnut as outer veneer. The veneer is glued together with water-soluble urea-formaldehyde glue.

MADE-TO-ORDER

Non-standard configurations (special colours, upholstery etc.) are available upon request at a minimum order quantity.

TEST & CERTIFICATION

PEFC™ PEFC/09-31-068: Grand Prix™ (3130) in beech, oak and walnut and painted shells are PEFC certified. This PEFC certification ensures the wood is from forests that are managed with respect for the ecological, social and ethical standards. At the moment Grand Prix™ (4130) with wooden legs are not PEFC certified.

GreenGuard: Grand Prix™ is GreenGuard Gold certified. GreenGuard certification is an emission certification for indoor air quality. Products with ultra-low-emitting materials can achieve GreenGuard Gold.

The Grand Prix™ chair with steel base or wooden legs complies with the requirements for EN 16139 L1 + EN 1728 + EN 1022, safety, strength, durability and stability, non domestic seating.

PACKAGING

PE foam and cardboard are used as protection between stacked chairs. The chairs are covered with a plastic bag and shipped in cardboard. All packaging material can be recycled.

CLEANING AND CARE

Plastic and powder coated surfaces: Clean the plastic shell by wiping it with a dry cloth. Dirt can be removed with a cloth wrung out in lukewarm water. If this does not remove the dirt, a mild solution containing a universal cleaning agent or dishwashing liquid may be used. Then dry off the shell with a cloth wrung out in clean water and finish by wiping with a dry cloth.

Chromed surfaces: Chrome can be wiped with a dry or damp cloth wrung in soapy water, and then wiped with a dry cloth afterwards.

Note: Do not use solvents on coated frames. thorough cleaning For thorough cleaning chrome surfaces can be wiped with a cloth moistened with alcohol.

REPAIR, DISPOSAL AND REUSE

In case of repair and disposal the chairs can be disassembled into two parts (shell and base). The base and all other metal parts can be recycled. Check local regulations for recycling options and whether there is potential for reuse.

WARRANTY

Fritz Hansen provides a five-year warranty on standard products against defects in materials and workmanship.

An extended warranty of up to twenty years is provided on selected products provided they have been registered online on FRITZHANSEN.COM/MY-FH.

Extended (10 years):

Base, Shell, Lacquer, Coloured ash, Natural veneer, Leather: Aura, Grace, Embrace, White, Optical white, Rustik, Natural

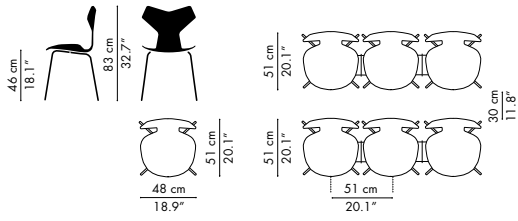

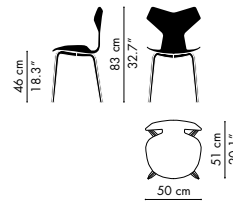
