## Plywood Group CTM

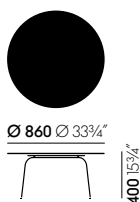
With the aim of producing a round coffee table, Charles and Ray Eames pursued various experiments that ultimately resulted in the CTM table (Coffee Table Metal). Designed in 1946, this simple table has a round plywood top with a slightly

raised moulded edge and four slender tubular steel legs. It is ideally suited for use with other designs from the Plywood Group by Charles and Ray Eames.

### Materials

- **CTM = Coffee Table Metal**
- **Table top:** moulded plywood with face veneer in ash or walnut, slightly indented centre.
- **Base:** tubular steel, chrome-plated or powder-coated.
- **Glides:** carpet glides.
