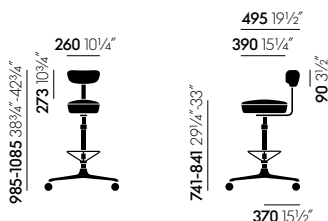
Nelson Perch

The Nelson Perch was designed in 1964 in conjunction with the revolutionary open-plan office system Action Office 1. This high stool encourages working positions that alternate between standing and sitting. It also serves as an ideal object for leaning on, providing healthy support during informal meetings at stand-up tables. The armrest and steel foot ring allow the user to adopt a variety of comfortable postures.

Materials

- **Seat and arm support:** upholstered in leather.
- **Base:** round tubular steel column, basic dark finish. Chrome-plated tubular steel foot ring; five-star base (flat) in die-cast aluminium, chrome-plated finish.
- **Height adjustment:** via spindle.
- **Castors:** soft reverse-brake castors.

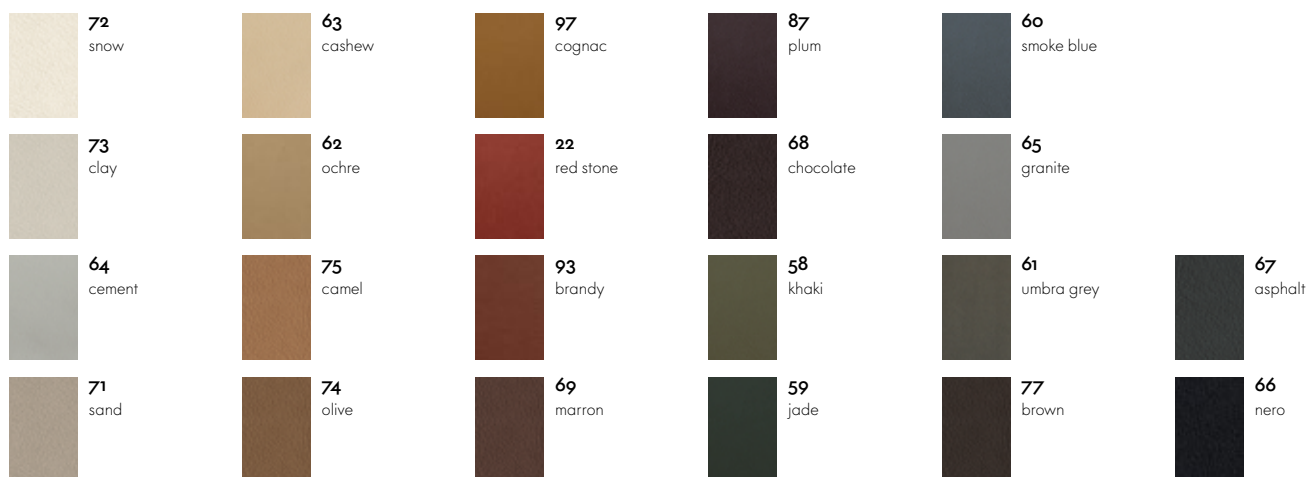

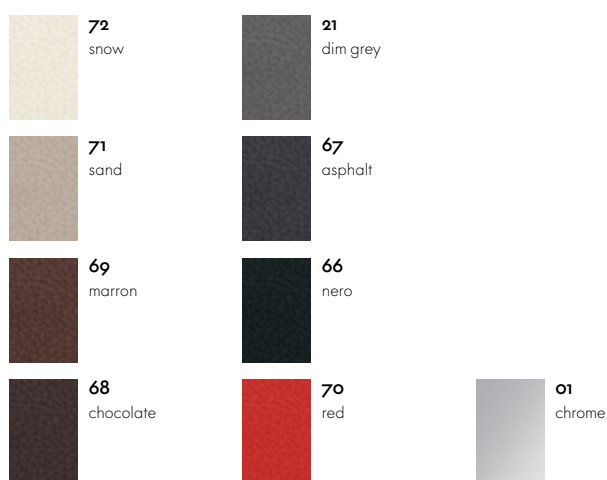
